

URGENT COMMUNIQUÉ N°38/IUGET/COGE/03-26-pk

Regarding the Urgency of Obtaining Continuous Assessment (CA) Marks in all Subjects for Bachelor, Master and MBA (under the mentorship of the Douala and Bamenda Universities)

It has come to our attention, with regret, that many students are taking **Continuous Assessment (CA)** marks lightly. Some do not even bother to complete the remedial exercises that their lecturers take the trouble to offer for evaluation long after the classroom assessments have taken place. This occurs even for students who have missed classes or who, for sometimes questionable reasons, registered late in which the Program Coordinators do their best to intercede with lecturers on their behalf.

IUGET wishes to remind everyone that education is not a commodity. The mere fact of having paid tuition fees (even in full) does not entitle a student to a mark, but rather to an **evaluation** resulting in a mark. Furthermore, we remind all those concerned that only students with CA marks in a subject are permitted to sit for that subject during the **Normal Session**. Finally, only students who took part in the Normal Session may, if necessary, sit for the **Reseat Session**.

By this notice, IUGET disclaims and distances itself from the irresponsible and unethical behavior of students who deliberately evade evaluations in the hope of receiving "ghost marks." The institution remains fully available to support those facing genuine problems; such students must urgently contact their **School Directors** with supporting evidence for their claims no later than **Wednesday, March 11, at 5:00 PM**.

In any event, all students who, as of **March 12, 2026**, do not have Continuous Assessment marks will bear full and sole responsibility for the consequences.
